UPCOMING ACTIONS

Thursday, January 11 (closing arguments in Trump Civil Case) 8:30AM Meet at 40 Centre St.

This is the last day of the civil case, and both sides will be making their closing arguments. Trump has said that he will attend; regardless there will be lots of press outside the court. It is a great opportunity to get our message out. We will be bringing our new "NO DICTATORS In The USA" banner, and lots of signs. We are meeting at 40 Centre St. (court is at 60 Centre St.) to assess the NYPD presence and to figure out where to demonstrate most visibly.

Thursday, January 11, Immigration Vigil 5PM at Times Square Subway Station Join us to protest Mayor Adam's decision to evict asylum seekers from the NYC shelters after 60 days - in violation of the right to shelter laws. No one should have to sleep on the street, and no families should have to move and reapply for housing. The Mayor continues to pit city residents against asylum seekers and to use migrants as excuses for budget cuts.

Tuesday, January 16 8:30 AM (start of part 2 of E. Jean Carroll defamation case Part 2 of the E. Jean Carroll defamation case. 8:30 am at the Daniel Patrick Moynihan courthouse. Entrance is at Worth & Baxter. We are there more to support E. Jean Carroll. Messages: No One is Above the Law. Trump is a rapist. Jury just has to determine damages.
