There are several drag story hour defense actions coming up. If you want to be notified and aren't already on the list, let Jamie know.

Thursday, **Feb. 23** - The Immigration Vigil will be held at 5 PM in Grand Central Terminal. People are encouraged to come. The more signs and pictures we can put out, the better. Discussion held about messaging. People have a right to migrate and seek asylum and that's being denied by Scotus and the Biden administration. People are being forced to wait for their asylum hearing in other countries, which is a contradiction because the request for asylum is based on the danger of the situation they are in, plus U.S. law says they must be in the U.S. to apply.

Also **Thursday**, **Feb. 23** - 11 AM outside Hochul's office, SAFETY MEANS INVESTMENT, VOCAL, NYCC, Housing for Justice for All are pushing back on police budget.

Friday, Feb. 25 - DSA action against Adams austerity budget.

Tuesday, Feb. 28 - Bannon has a court date at 100 Centre St. He's trying to change his lawyers (not the ones he hasn't paid.) We might want to add a sign about the payment issue. Meet at 8:15 AM, court opens at 9 AM.

Wednesday, March 1 - 9 AM rally on City Hall steps, followed by 10 AM City Council hearing on the NYPD's Strategic Response Group. This hearing had been postponed twice because SRG wouldn't show up for earlier dates. The NYCLU got a commitment that the hearing will proceed whether or not the cops participate. Friday, March 10 - Roger Stone will attend the Trumpist New York Young Republicans Club. More details to follow.

Wednesday, March 29 - The Elevator Action Group reports that an MTA board meeting protest/rally is in planning stages. Jennifer proposes spending \$300 instead of usual \$200 on posters for actions. Will come back with further details. Jennifer also mentions a noon rally tomorrow at Pershing Square, where the Rider's Alliance will call on Gov. Hochul to invest in frequency of transportation which is an accessibility issue too (if, for instance, there are only two spaces for disabled people on a bus and the buses take 35 minutes to arrive, it's very problematic.) The EAG signed onto a letter of support on behalf of Rise and Resist.

Several climate actions:

- Thursday, Feb. 23: Extinction Rebellion will be interrupting Citibank recruiting at NYU.
- Friday, Feb. 24: A colorful, kid-friendly action taking place at 1271 6th Ave at noon, calling on AIG to stop insuring fossil fuel projects.
- Tuesday, March 21 Major climate action starts at Dag Hammarskjold Plaza 47th and 2nd, sponsored by Third Act.

ELECTIONS COMMITTEE UPDATE- Still strategizing over Jay Jacobs, and reaching out to other groups to diversify the voices. Elections meetings are on Wednesdays at 5 PM.

RISE AND RESIST EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM

New name is Strategic Response Team.

ERT was a 7-member group created to deal with urgent-seeming issues that came up between meetings. It originally approved all letters, which was too much, so letter-signing approval was turned over to the working groups. Since that, it hasn't been consulted for years and only two RAR active people are now involved. It came up because we needed approval of \$900 for the video truck for the Fox protest this week, so Livvie reached out to ERT. ERT approved the budget, but it raised the issue of who should be on ERT and how it should function.

- We decided on five team members, with three needed for approval. Members are Rick, Sandy, Wendy, Livvie, and Susan.
- Per our procedures, we re-voted on the \$900 budget approved by ERT, with 17 votes in favor, no opposed or abstaining.

Monday, Feb. 20 - Indict Presidents' Day pop-up at Central Park and 60th St. It was suggested by Jennie. Lots of positive responses on a nice day. No negativity. Kim did chalking and read out the indictments list. Ja

Tuesday, Feb. 21 - Big Truth Tuesday/FOX action with emphasis on Dominion suit with 30 participants taking up the whole plaza, plus an appearance by the special video truck mentioned above. (We watched the video for the truck that was created by Jonathan with Julie's signage.) The truck's generator broke down after a few minutes, so we got our \$900 refunded. The video Julie got of the truck and posted on TikTok during the time it was working currently has 5K likes, 500 comments that are more positive than usual, so we got a lot of bang for no bucks. The group is enthused about doing the truck again.

- New chant was "Fox knew and lied to you."
- Some participants were newcomers via Twitter.

Discussion about when to use truck again. Jackie points out that we have the money in general, plus we got a refund. Most people want to do the truck sooner rather than later. Julie definitely wants to do it in April when the Dominion lawsuit is set to go to trial.

Other discussion: Jennie proposes we hold MSNBC accountable for never covering the protest. Jay suggests we prepare for press around our two-year anniversary (August 24.)
